## THE CECIL DOWNING COLLECTION

I was born and raised during the Raj which explains the strong showing of notes in my collection.

My Farther was a British Officer serving in the Indian Army and was initially posted in the Hindu Kush with the Armoured Car Company based at Razmak and Bannu.

Postings to Lahore and Quetta followed and my father was present during the terrible earthquake in 1935, a most frightening experience, "when the earth moves you feel so helpless." The next posting was to Karachi where I was born, and with my two older brothers attended Karachi Grammar School.

When war broke out more moves followed, my father was posted to Madras and the three boys sent to an Army Boarding School near Wellington, in the Nilgiri Hills.

The next move was to Bangalore where we attended St. Joseph's High School, now called St. Josephs College of Art and Science.

A large Prisoner of War camp near Bhopal was our next "home" and education was provided at an Army school, classes were mornings only as it was too hot in the summer and too cold in the winter to spend all day there.

The defeat of the Afrika Korps in 1943 enabled troopships to sail to Britain and my much older brothers were able to return to England.

My Father's final posting was to take command of a Transit camp near Cochin where the rest of the family remained until after the war, returning to England before Partition.

I feel that after collecting for forty years it is now time to give other collectors the opportunity to own and appreciate my treasured notes.

## THE MIKE JOWETT COLLECTION

The Portuguese and Indian banknote collections were built up starting in the mid 1970's. At that time living in Nigeria and traveling home to the UK I was asked by a friend to bring uncirculated notes from the newly independent African Countries. In exchange he sent me notes from Portugal, Angola and Mozambique. I was soon collecting two notes, one for him and one for myself. In 1980 my friends Portuguese notes came on the market for sale, unfortunately I could only afford a few, but the collection was born. From then on supplemented by Spink auctions and dealers such as Mel Steinberg and Essie Kashani the collection has grown.

The Indian notes were largely accumulated in the late 1970's and early 1980's by writing to Indian banknote dealers. During the last few years there has been little available. Indian banknote collectors are dedicated and I have had wonderful email exchanges with many of them searching for this era of notes. As I now focus on my African collection I know others will share the pleasure I have had in holding these beautiful and historic notes.

'Almost 50 years ago a friend of Bill Parkinson who happened to be a bank clerk with Lloyds brought home some unusual banknotes which had been brought into the bank by an old farmer who wished to have them changed for 'proper' money. They turned out to be Warren Fisher Treasury notes, the like of which Bill had never seen before. He bought four of them for face value and that was the start of a lifelong fascination for British banknotes. As Bill's business flourished over the next forty years he was able to indulge his passion and build a remarkable collection which is the subject of this sale.'
